# PROFILE 2024-2025

#### ABOUT LIBERTY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

LCS is a private, Christian-based, college-prep school (grades K-12). We have decidedly chosen to not embrace Common Core in our curriculum, believing traditional approaches to studies are the most successful for student growth and development. Liberty students are well-rounded; they are developing their spiritual awareness, physical large and small motor skills, emotional well-being, and academic aptitude towards college pursuits. We also offer L.E.A.R.N. Academy for students with learning disabilities (about 15% - each class varies), and our high school has an international student population (under 10%).

#### **CURRICULUM**

K-6 academics are based on Bob Jones University Curriculum with teachers adding their own teaching styles and resources, sometimes using web-based enhancements like Classroom Dojo, and XtraMath. We also use Accelerated Reader to enhance the curriculum. Elementary electives include Sign Language, Library time, Music, Choir, Handbells, Band, and PE with 2 daily recesses and weekly chapel.

7th-12th academics are college-prep and based on curriculum standards and graduation requirements set forth in California State Standards combined with "a-g requirements" for the University of California system. Our curriculum publishers range from Bob Jones to Savvas, and McGraw Hill. We also offer robust online courses (BYU online) for advanced students or those who need remediation. Our students have earned competitive scholarships, full-ride military appointments, and prestigious college acceptances nationwide.

#### **ADMISSION**

- Prospective students/parents interview with the Principal as needed to discuss interest, education, and spiritual direction.
- Prospective students/parents interview with L.E.A.R.N. Academy Director as needed.
- Kindergarten Readiness test is administered for prospective kindergarten students.
- Enrollment application and registration fee are collected for acceptance.
- Entrance testing is required through our on-campus AR testing for math and reading comprehension. Placement recommendations follow

### GPA and CLASS RANKING

Academic GPA is determined by computing all grades except PE, athletics, and electives. AP and Honors classes are given 5 points on the 4.0 GPA scale.

Total GPA is determined by computing all grades.

Class Rank is calculated on the basis of the student's weighted total GPA, grades 9th-12th, as compared to other members in their class.

Valedictorian and Salutatorian is determined by weighted total GPA grades 9th-12th. Students must maintain good citizenship and be an LCS student for at least 3 semesters.

#### **ACHIEVEMENT TESTING**

K-6: Spring Iowa Assessments scores reveal that LCS students last year averaged 4 percentage points above national averages. These students also do quarterly Renaissance Star assessments in Reading and Math

**7-II:** PSAT tests are given to 7th-11th grades in the spring. These grades take the PSAT 8/9 and 10 versions. The high school was 58 points above the national total average last year with extremely high scores in English.
